

WORKSHOP ENGINEER, FABRICATOR, WELDER

Job Description

The role is based at our Bickerstaffe site. The work shall focus on the fabrication of industrial Roller Shutter doors and associated products for commercial and industrial buildings.

Responsibilities and duties:

- Working under the direction of the Site Manager
- Supervision and training of designated Workshop apprentices
- Maintain highest standards of safety, ensuring adherence to company HSE Policies at all times. Any spillages must be cleaned up immediately.
- Ensure the maintenance of workshop equipment ensuring all is in satisfactory working order at all times.
- Maintain good housekeeping practices in all areas of workshop.
- Fabrication of Roller Shutter Doors and associated products.
- Rolling lath sections.
- Communicate effectively with colleagues at all levels to ensure satisfactory information transfer
- Required to work off site as and when required
- Ensure that the correct interpretation of drawings is accurate prior to fabrication.
- Organise the collection and delivery of powder coating
- When checking out jobs with the fitters ensure all parts are handed over.
- Ensure all new shutters and curtains with rails are badged up.
- Ensure appropriate PPE is always worn in workshop/site/van. (No tracksuits or trainers).
- Responsibility for checking and unloading deliveries. Including powder coating quality.
- Control and deliver the required materials ensuring that all works are managed and controlled in a cost effective and efficient manner.
- All accidents must be reported and recorded in accident book in office on the same day.
- Ensure if you are the last leaving the workshop- all shutters are secure. All machinery is switched off. All lights in workshop and van store are switched off. All gas containers must be switched off. Compressor must be emptied every night. Store shutter is locked.

Benefits:

- 40 hour working week
- 21 days holiday (excluding bank holidays)
- Hours of work are 8am to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday - although you should have a flexible approach and be prepared to work additional hours - evenings and weekends, as and when required.
- 30 minute a day lunch break
- Standard pay rate £9.00 to £13.00 per hour, depending on experience.
- Overtime rate: Mon – Fri – out of normal hours = time and half, Sat = Time and a half Sunday Double time
- Driving licence required.
